Clothing

- Maroon School blazer worn with school badge at all times.
- Grey V-neck jumper or tank top with Conisborough College logo
- White long-sleeved shirt—that buttons to the neck and is worn with a school tie. During the summer term a short-sleeved shirt may be worn. During the Winter a plain white t-shirt maybe worn under the shirt.
- Maroon & Gold striped school tie should be to the waist.
- Year Group Lanyard to be worn at all times
- Plain black or grey socks or tights (NO socks over tights).
- Grey pleated or A-line skirt to be worn to the knee.
- Grey tailored trousers (no skinny fit) should be worn at the waist.
- (Optional) Plain black belt with no large buckles
- Religious Headwear must be plain black or maroon.
- No caps or snapback hats to be worn

Shoes

- Plain black polishable shoes (should NOT look like trainers).
- Laces (if needed) must be black.
- No trainers, Converse, canvas ('Vans') or boots above the ankle.

Jewellery, Hair & Make-Up

- No Make-up.
- One pair of plain stud earrings (on lower lobe) No diamonte/diamond earrings
- No other body piercings e.g. nose, eyebrows, lip or tongue studs.
- No acrylic/false nails or nail varnish.
- No jewellery; rings, necklaces, bracelets etc.
- No unnatural hair colouring or shaved patterns.
- Any hair additions must be of natural hair colouring.
- No false eye lashes
- Hair bands must be black or grey and of a simple design.
- No Durags / No Bonnets

PE Kit

- Conisborough PE Kit.
- Plain black or grey socks.
- Trainers not plimsolls.
- Long hair must be tied back.
