Dear Parents,

It is very important that you know and understand that you are responsible for protecting your son/daughter from internet dangers and accessing inappropriate information and materials, when they are using the laptop, from home.

The school is unable to control internet searches carried out at home as this computer is not part of the school's network. **It is your responsibility to set up internet protection and filtering using parent 'Internet Controls'.**

Setting up Parental Controls

The easiest way to set up controls is by using those which your internet provider has designed and set up already. (they have to have these provisions within their services to you).
