## Year 11 Parents' Evening - Thursday 21st January 2021 - Online Appointment Booking

We warmly invite you to our Year 11 Parents Evening on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> January 2021 between the hours of 4.00 – 7.00pm. This is an important occasion for you and your child as you will be able to meet with all their subject teachers and discuss their recent mock exam results and progress.

You will be able to attend by making a virtual video appointment with your child/ren's subject teachers using our new SchoolCloud platform. The booking system opens and is available to you from 9:00am from Friday 15<sup>th</sup> January and up until 3.00pm on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> January 2021, the day of the Parents Evening. This gives you longer to make your appointments than usual.

The virtual video calls will last 5 minutes for each subject teacher's parental consultation.

We are running this new and easy to use online appointment booking system that allows you to choose your own appointment times with teachers. Once completed, you will receive a confirmation email of your booked appointments. We strongly encourage you to meet with all you child's subject teachers.

A link to the Zoom session will be sent on Monday morning and we will be talking it through with Year 11 in their assembly ay 8.40am on Monday morning as well.

(A short guide on how to add appointments is included with this letter). By going onto our website this will take you to the booking system.

## Advice for the evening itself – Thursday 21st January 4.00 – 7.00pm

- Ensure where possible that you are in a quiet area
- Ideally have your child attend with you
- If possible, speak to your child about their learning and or concerns before the meeting so you have any questions ready.
- If possible, please have your mock exam results with you. If you have lost or not received your mock exams results, please contact Mrs Maloney urgently. They were sent home to all parent after the Year 11 assembly on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> December.

Sadly, we have yet to receive any information about the grading process for this summer. When we do, we will share this with you immediate.

What we do know is it is so very important for your child to take charge of their grades as much as possible. This can be done by making sure that all assessments set are completed to the best of their ability, in full and handed into their teachers. This ensures that their teachers have a good evidence base for making decisions about attainment, progress and can grade their work. This hopefully will show them in a strong position. We want the best for all our young people as we are aware of how very important these grades are for post-16 applications and beyond. Their actual results are crucial.

We will continue to provide support and guidance as we roll out this new communication system for subsequent Parents Evenings. The next Parents Evening will be for Year 9 parents regarding Options.

## **Video Appointments: Parents**

## How to attend appointments over video call

This video shows you how to log in to book, and later attend, video appointments at your school's Parents Evening. Underneath the video is a help article with written information to the same effect and, at the bottom, details of **how to invite another parent/guardian to join your appointments**.

### In order to make video calls you need to have as a minimum:

• a device with a microphone and speaker/headphones

• a compatible up-to-date web browser:

iPhone/iPad: Safari Note: there is a known issue joining video calls using iOS 14.2. Please upgrade any iOS 14.2 devices to iOS 14.3, or use an alternate device.

**Android:** Chrome or Firefox

Windows: Chrome, Firefox or Microsoft Edge (Chromium - download here)

Mac: Safari, Chrome or Firefox Linux: Chrome or Firefox

### We also recommend:

- Using your smartphone for video appointments. If you don't have a smartphone with a front-facing camera, use a laptop or computer with a webcam.
- Using a headset (or earphones with a microphone) to reduce echo.

How to attend your appointments via video call

1. Log in and go to the Evening

On the day of the video appointments (or before, if you want to test your camera and microphone) login to Parents Evening at the usual web address for your school or click the login link from the bottom of the email confirmation you will have received.

Once logged in you will see a notice that you have upcoming video appointments and under this the details of the event, along with a *Join Video Appointments* button.

Press the button to join your appointment on the day - or to test your camera/microphone at any time.



2. Check Audio and Video

When you click *Join Video Appointments* the *Check Audio and Video* screen will be displayed. You may at this point be asked if you wish to allow access to your camera/microphone, in which case please click yes.




From here you can turn on or off your microphone and camera, change which devices are being used for the call, and check your microphone and speakers. Once you are happy, click *Proceed to Video Call*.


## 2. The Video Call

On this screen you can see the following, when in a call:

- At the top left the teacher name (and subject details) for the current and next appointment
- At the top right a countdown to the start of the appointment.
- At the bottom the controls for the microphone and camera.




• In the middle, when your appointment is due to start, the *Start Appointment* button.



## 3. Making a call

Click the *Start Appointment* button. You will see yourself in the bottom right corner of the screen (unless you have no camera, or have chosen to turn it off). If the teacher has not yet joined you will see a notice to that effect in the centre of the screen.



When a teacher joins a call you will see them in the main part of the screen - or hear them, if they have no camera (or have turned it off) - and can start your discussion with them.

You will also see the remaining time for the appointment counting down in a blue bar at the top of the screen, which will turn red when the last 10 seconds begin.

If anyone loses access to the system for some reason during the call, they can log in again and click *Start Appointment* on the video call screen. As long as the other person is still in the call this will let you continue with the appointment.

When the countdown in the blue bar stops the appointment time is over and the call will automatically end.

**Note** that if you or the teacher are late, or leave and rejoin the call, it does **not** reset the timer. The appointment will always end at the scheduled time.


#### 4. Follow on calls

If you have a consecutive appointment scheduled the screen will display a *Start Next Appointment* button. When you are ready to proceed, click on it

**Note** that if you delay starting a call it does **not** extend the duration for that appointment. The appointment will always end at the scheduled times.

If you do not have a consecutive appointment, but you have not completed your final scheduled appointment you will see a countdown telling you how long until the start of your next appointment.

Once your final appointment for the evening is complete you will see a message advising you of this.




### Inviting another parent/guardian to join your appointments

You can give one other parent/guardian access to join your video appointments in respect of each student linked to you that is involved in the conference. You can grant this access at the time of booking, or later if required.


1. Once you have made your bookings (or when you later log in and go to *My Bookings*) click on the *Invite*Parent/Guardian link at the top of the list of your bookings. If you have already sent an invitation this link will

show as Manage Invites instead.



2. You will then be presented with a box asking for the details of the parent/guardian to be given access.

If there is more than one student linked to you and involved in the evening they will all be shown.





If there is more than one student linked to you, choose the student(s) in respect of whose appointments the access to this person will be granted.


When you click the blue *Send Invite* button an email is sent to the address entered, giving them a link and details on how to join the call.

Here is an example of what the invite email looks like:

3. You will then see a *Manage invites* box that shows your sent invitation(s), allows you to add another invite if you have any more available (the person invited can be different for each student, if wished), and allows you to *Resend* invites or *Remove* them.



If you click *Remove* the link in the previously sent invitation will no longer work and that person can no longer join the video call.
