**Adverse weather Conditions: heatwave alert**

As you are aware the government has issued an amber weather warning for the period Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> – Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> July next week. In addition to this we have also received guidance from the local authority and the Department for Education about school age pupils being outside in temperatures over 30 degrees.

With all the advice and guidance, we have received we are going to amend our school day on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> July.

Sadly, we will not be able to hold our Sports Day on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> July and we will have to look at alternative arrangements for School Concert which was due to take place on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> July.

We are amending the school day for 2 days next week as follows:

Monday 18<sup>th</sup> July: School starts as usual at 8.30am but finishes early at 12.10pm.

Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> July: Sports Day cancelled. School starts as usual at 8.30am but finishes early at 12.10pm.

Lesson will start earlier at 8.30am but this is still the usual time that all students are all meant to be in school.

Period 1: 8.30 – 9.20am

Period 2: 9.20 – 10.10am

Morning Break/Brunch: 10.10 – 10.30am. the free School Meal allocation will be made available at this time and a larger food service than normal will be available at morning break

Period 3: 10.30 – 11.20am

Period 4: 11.20 – 12.10pm.

All students will be dismissed to go home at 12.20pm as the temperatures continue to rise. It is important please that student do go straight home and are inside avoiding the high temperatures.

Please can you make sure that your child has plenty of water with them (this can be topped up at school), has sunscreen with them, and a hat to protect themselves from the sun as they make their way home safely. They do not need coats and hoodies should not be in school. There is no need to wear ties and blazers either as is currently the case. There will be no outdoor lessons in any temperatures over 30 degrees.

Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> July: School starts as usual at 8.30am and finishes as usual at 2.50pm.  
Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> July: School starts as usual at 8.30am but finishes early at 12.30pm with a phased dismissal of students as usual at the end of the school year.


As Sports Day is cancelled on Tuesday, it will be a normal school day. Students should come to school in regular summer school uniform and be equipped to attend normal lessons.
